## MAPLE QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE



### Hedge Maple

*Acer campestre*

HEIGHT: 30' WIDTH: 30' ZONE: 5

FOLIAGE: Smaller handsome dark green leaves in summer.

FALL COLOR: Yellow sometimes flushed with red in autumn.

BLOOM/FRUIT: Very sparse, yellowish-green clusters in May. Flowers followed by insignificant samara.

BARK: Grey-black, lightly ridged and furrowed bark.

GROWTH HABIT: A small, slow-growing tree that is rounded and dense. This low-branched tree is clay soil, air pollution and insect tolerant.



### Autumn Blaze® Maple

*Acer x freemanii 'Jeffersred'*

HEIGHT: 50' WIDTH: 40' ZONE: 4

FOLIAGE: Pleasing lettuce-green leaves throughout summer.

FALL COLOR: Brilliant long-lasting orange-red to scarlet-red fall color living up to its name "Autumn Bze."

BLOOM/FRUIT: Sparse greenish-yellow to red flowers rarely blooming followed by insignificant fruit.

BARK: Greyish-tan, semi-smooth bark.

GROWTH HABIT: This rapid, vigorous grower has an upright form, broad oval crown and strong ascending branching pattern.



### Bloodgood Maple

*Acer palmatum 'Bloodgood'*

HEIGHT: 18' WIDTH: 18' ZONE: 5

FOLIAGE: Deep reddish-purple to deep red foliage retains its color throughout summer.

FALL COLOR: Crimson-red fall color.

BLOOM/FRUIT: Insignificant purplish-red flowers bloom in April followed by showy red samaras in late summer to early fall.

BARK: Attractive grey-tan bark is lightly ridged and furrowed.

GROWTH HABIT: Low maintenance, slow grower with an upright form. Becomes broad topped with age.



### Celebration® Maple

*Acer x freemanii 'Celzam'*

HEIGHT: 50' WIDTH: 35' ZONE: 4

FOLIAGE: Green leaves are deeply cut and resemble those of silver maple.

FALL COLOR: Early fall color of red, purple and gold hues.

BLOOM/FRUIT: Flowers, if they present at all, appear in late April to May, in dense red clusters at the end of one-year-old branches. Male seedless form.

BARK: Light brown, grey and tan, patchy, furrowed bark.

GROWTH HABIT: Upright, compact, distinctly pyramidal habit. Limbs resist breakage as well as disease resistant.



### Tamukeyama Maple

*Acer palmatum dissectum 'Tamukeyama'*

HEIGHT: 8' WIDTH: 12' ZONE: 5

FOLIAGE: Leaves feature deeply cut and dissected, lace-like texture. Rich dark purple-red leaves that hold their color even in hot humid conditions.

FALL COLOR: Brighter red fall color.

BLOOM/FRUIT: Insignificant reddish-purple flowers in April followed by winged samaras in pairs.

BARK: Grey-green, semi-smooth bark.

GROWTH HABIT: This vigorous grower has long cascading branches and grows in a mound or dome shape.



### Sienna Glen® Maple

*Acer x freemanii 'Sienna'*

HEIGHT: 50' WIDTH: 35' ZONE: 3

FOLIAGE: Green foliage.

FALL COLOR: Outstanding shades of orange-red and burgundy in the fall.

BLOOM/FRUIT: Showy clusters of red flowers along the branches in early spring followed by insignificant fruit.

BARK: Furrowed grey bark and brick red branches.

GROWTH HABIT: Fast growing with uniform branching. Pyramidal, oval form shows excellent winter hardiness. Not susceptible to frost crack or sun-scald.



### Crimson King Maple

*Acer platanoides 'Crimson King'*

HEIGHT: 40' WIDTH: 35' ZONE: 4

FOLIAGE: Deep crimson-purple foliage retains its beautiful color throughout summer.

FALL COLOR: Unremarkable maroon to reddish-bronze fall color.

BLOOM/FRUIT: Interesting and showy maroon-purple flower clusters in March to April are followed by purple paired seeds (2" samaras).

BARK: Grey and deeply furrowed bark.

GROWTH HABIT: Compact, has an oval shape becoming rounded with age.



### State Street™ Maple

*Acer miyabei 'Morton'*

HEIGHT: 50' WIDTH: 35' ZONE: 4

FOLIAGE: Thick, crisp-green leaves stay well into October.

FALL COLOR: Golden-yellow in late fall.

BLOOM/FRUIT: Insignificant greenish-yellow flowers in April. Flowers give way to insignificant two-winged samaras.

BARK: Grey-brown corky bark.

GROWTH HABIT: Uniform, symmetrical, densely branched tree with an upright rounded habit.

Good specimen tree for lawns or street and excellent adaptability.



### Crimson Sentry Maple

*Acer platanoides 'Crimson Sentry'*

HEIGHT: 25' WIDTH: 15' ZONE: 4

FOLIAGE: Deep purple leaves.

FALL COLOR: Maroon to reddish-bronze in fall.

Bloom/Fruit: Stunning corymbs of lemon-yellow flowers in spring. Fruit is insignificant.

BARK: Attractive shades of tan and light brown, semi-smooth bark.

GROWTH HABIT: Upright, heavily branched habit with a compact canopy. Fits well in areas where a smaller tree is desired. Salt, urban and deer tolerant.



Deborah Maple

Acer platanoides 'Deborah'

HEIGHT: 45'    WIDTH: 40'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Reddish-purple in the spring turning to dark bronze-green in the summer.  
**FALL COLOR:** Bronze fall color.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Small yellow flowers form erect clusters in March to April, giving way to paired seeds with horizontally spreading wings (samaras up to 2" long).  
**BARK:** Grey-brown, semi-smooth bark.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** A vigorous grower forming a broadly oval to rounded head and straight central leader.



Redpointe® Maple

Acer rubrum 'Frank Jr.', PP16,769

HEIGHT: 45'    WIDTH: 30'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Dark green, heat resistant.  
**FALL COLOR:** Turns bright red in the fall.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Showy clusters of red flowers along the branches in early spring before the leaves.  
**BARK:** Furrowed silvery bark.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** A broadly pyramidal form with a straight dominant central leader results in strong branch angles that make it easier to grow.



Royal Red Maple

Acer platanoides 'Royal Red'

HEIGHT: 40'    WIDTH: 30'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Crimson-purple leaves.  
**FALL COLOR:** Outstanding purple-maroon to reddish-bronze color in autumn.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Covered in stunning corymbs of lemon-yellow flowers in early spring before the leaves emerge. Fruit is insignificant.  
**BARK:** Tan and yellowish-grey streaked, moderately ridged bark.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This low maintenance tree is the hardiest of the purple leaf maples, forming a moderately globe shape.



Red Sunset® Maple

Acer rubrum 'Franksred'

HEIGHT: 45'    WIDTH: 35'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Lustrous, glossy-green throughout summer.  
**FALL COLOR:** Brilliant shades of red and orange-red in autumn.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Red flowers form dense clusters in late March to April followed by red fruit.  
**BARK:** Smooth, light grey bark.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Vigorous grower that forms strong symmetrical branching and an oval shape. New growth, leaves, leafstalks, twigs, flowers, fruit and fall color are red or tinged with red.



Armstrong Maple

Acer rubrum 'Armstrong'

HEIGHT: 45'    WIDTH: 15'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Large, green, star-shaped, three-lobed leaves.  
**FALL COLOR:** Yellow, orange or red in fall.  
**Bloom/Fruit:** Reddish-green flowers in April and again in winter. Fruit attracts small animals.  
**BARK:** Silvery-grey, thin bark is deeply furrowed and ridged.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Fast grower with moderate, columnar, upright crown and very narrow habit. Winter interest due to unusual form, fruit, showy winter trunk and winter flowers.



Commemoration® Maple

Acer saccharum 'Commemoration'

HEIGHT: 55'    WIDTH: 35'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Thick, heavily textured, glossy, dark-green leaves are resistant to leaf tatter.  
**FALL COLOR:** Pumpkin-orange with blushes of red almost two weeks before the species.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Insignificant flowers or fruit.  
**BARK:** Interesting, deeply furrowed bark in shades of brown.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Vigorous, fast-growing shade tree with a dense canopy and resistant to city heat.



Brandywine Maple

Acer rubrum 'Brandywine'

HEIGHT: 40'    WIDTH: 30'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Green above and greyish-green underneath.  
**FALL COLOR:** Fall color is a brilliant scarlet-red that gradually turns reddish-purple.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Insignificant blue-grey bloom in early spring. Seedless male selection.  
**BARK:** Stark grey bark that looks attractive in the winter.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This medium to fast grower has an oval to rounded shape becoming broad with age.



Green Mountain® Maple

Acer saccharum 'Green Mountain'

HEIGHT: 50'    WIDTH: 35'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Green leaves with a thick, waxy coating.  
**FALL COLOR:** Excellent shades of orange and scarlet in autumn.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Pale yellowish-green flowers appear in clusters in spring followed by clusters of samaras.  
**BARK:** The bark forms attractive bright grey plates, which stand out especially during the winter.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This vigorous grower forms a broad oval crown and is resistant to leaf hoppers and leaf scorch.



October Glory® Maple

Acer rubrum 'October Glory'

HEIGHT: 40'    WIDTH: 35'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Shiny dark green leaves with red stems and good color well into fall.  
**FALL COLOR:** Brilliant crimson-red in fall and the colorful leaves remain on the tree longer than other red maples  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Attractive red flowers appear in early spring giving way to red-tinged samaras.  
**BARK:** Grey-green and tan mottled bark.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This popular fast growing tree has an upright form, a dense broad-oval crown and ascending branching.



Legacy® Maple

Acer saccharum 'Legacy'

HEIGHT: 55'    WIDTH: 40'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Thick, waxy green leaves have a definite sheen and are resistant to tatter and burn.

*Cercis canadensis 'Ace of Hearts'*

HEIGHT: 12'    WIDTH: 12'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Unique heart-shaped leaves emerge bronze and mature to a kelly-green and stack like roof shingles.  
**BLOOM:** Prolific pink blooms.  
**BLOOM TIME:** Spring  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Dwarf form.



### Black Pearl™ Redbud

*Cercis canadensis 'IN16', US PP28,627 P3*

HEIGHT: 20'    WIDTH: 5'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Extremely deep purple leaves that have an almost black appearance and keeps color throughout summer.  
**BLOOM:** Up to 8,000 lavender flowers.  
**BLOOM TIME:** Mid-spring  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This moderately vigorous grower forms a compact dense habit with relatively short internodes



### Forest Pansy Redbud

*Cercis canadensis 'Forest Pansy'*

## QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE



### Pagoda Dogwood

*Cornus alternifolia*

HEIGHT: 25'    WIDTH: 35'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Elliptic-ovate, medium green leaves turn purple in fall.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Tiny yellowish-white, fragrant flower clusters. Bluish-black berries mature in late summer.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Flower clusters are 2-½ to 3."  
**BLOOM TIME:** May to June.  
**BARK:** Bark is thin and grey, mostly smooth, often with lighter brown.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Very hardy, small, rounded ornamental tree. Branches form layers.



### Cherokee Brave Dogwood

*Cornus florida rubra 'Comco No. 1'*

HEIGHT: 30'    WIDTH: 35'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** New growth is reddish-green, turning to rich green as the leaves mature. Brilliant burgundy-red fall color.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Deep pink-red bracts fading to white in center, prior to emerging leaves, followed by glossy, vivid-red fruit clusters in fall.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts are 3-½ to 4-½" across.  
**BLOOM TIME:** April to May  
**BARK:** Rough, dark grey bark with a square mosaic-like texture.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This extremely vigorous grower forms a broadly-pyramidal habit, but somewhat flat-topped with a rounded crown.



### Cloud 9 Dogwood

*Cornus florida 'Cloud 9'*

HEIGHT: 15'    WIDTH: 10'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Oval, dark green leaves turn rust-red in autumn.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Large, white overlapping bracts. Flowers profusely at a young age and produces bright-red fruit in fall.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts are 4 to 5."  
**BLOOM TIME:** March to April.  
**BARK:** Rough, medium-brown.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This slow grower has a spreading, broadly rounded crown.



### Eddie's White Wonder Dogwood

*Cornus nutallii x florida 'Eddie's White Wonder'*

HEIGHT: 35'    WIDTH: 20'    ZONE: 7

**FOLIAGE:** Medium green leaves are larger and turn red in the fall.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Pure white with broad overlapping bracts.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** 4"  
**BLOOM TIME:** Late spring.  
**BARK:** Peeling grey with indian red branches.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Dense, drooping habit that can be asymmetrical. Resistant to dogwood anthracnose.



### Ragin' Red™ Dogwood

*Cornus florida 'IN13', US PP29,424 P3*

HEIGHT: 30'    WIDTH: 20'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Flowers are followed by striking red new growth. Dark red leaves become green with development; deep burgundy fall color.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Single-type flowers are red-purple in color followed by red fruit in fall.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts are 3."  
**BLOOM TIME:** Spring  
**BARK:** Slightly rough, tan to brown bark.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This vigorous grower develops an upright and outwardly spreading form.



### Blue Ray™ Dogwood

*Cornus kousa 'IN6', US PP28,936 P2*

HEIGHT: 20'    WIDTH: 20'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Dark green foliage with a bluish cast, have a glossy sheen and red fall color.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** White four-pointed bracts surrounding tiny flower clusters followed in fall by small red fruit.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts are 3 to 4" across.  
**BLOOM TIME:** Spring  
**BARK:** Glabrous and covered with lenticels.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** This moderate grower forms a vase-shape silhouette with a spreading habit.

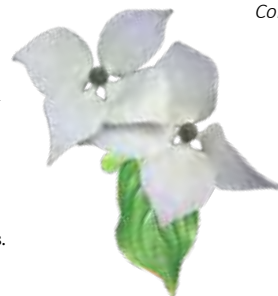


### Chinese Dogwood

*Cornus kousa chinensis*

HEIGHT: 20'    WIDTH: 20'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Deep green foliage changes to scarlet in the fall.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Prolific ivory-white star-shaped blooms in abundance followed by 1 to 1-½" red fruit.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts are 3-½ to 4" across.  
**BLOOM TIME:** May to June  
**BARK:** Older bark develops an exfoliating character, revealing a mix of grey-tan and mahogany brown.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Small but hardy tree.



### Galilean® Dogwood

*Cornus kousa chinensis 'Galzam'*

HEIGHT: 25'    WIDTH: 20'    ZONE: 4

**FOLIAGE:** Leaves emerge light green and mature to a large, glossy, hunter green in summer; burgundy and red fall color.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Bright-white blooms are followed by abundant red berries early to mid-fall.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts are 6."  
**BLOOM TIME:** Late spring to summer.  
**BARK:** Grey bark resembles a jigsaw puzzle.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Heavy, broad, upright vase that becomes rounded at maturity.



### Heart Throb® Dogwood


*Cornus kousa 'Schmred'*

HEIGHT: 20'    WIDTH: 20'    ZONE: 5

**FOLIAGE:** Bright bluish-green leaves turn to dark burgundy-red in fall.  
**BLOOM/FRUIT:** At a young age, flowers are white, maturing to deep rose-pink. Large ¾," red, raspberry-like fruit, mid to late summer.  
**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts are 4" across.  
**BLOOM TIME:** Late spring lasting up to two months in Oregon.  
**BARK:** Attractive mottled, exfoliating bark.  
**GROWTH HABIT:** Moderate grower with a rounded form. At an early age exhibits good branching.







### Radiant Rose® Dogwood

*Cornus kousa chinensis ‘Hanros’*

**HEIGHT:** 20’    **WIDTH:** 18’    **ZONE:** 5

**LEAF:** Heavily textured, dark green leaves tinged with red turn a deep orange-red color in the fall.


**BLOOM/FRUIT:** Large rich-red to red-pink blooms followed by red strawberry-like fruit in late summer to early fall.

**BLOOM SIZE:** Bracts measure 6” across.

**BLOOM TIME:** May to June, lasting 2 to 3 weeks.

**FOLIAGE:** Mottled, slightly peeling bark.

**GROWTH HABIT:** Moderate grower with spreading, arching habit. More cold and heat tolerant than the species.



### Rosy Teacups® Dogwood

*Cornus kousa x nuttallii ‘KN144-2’ US PP26, 211 P3*

**HEIGHT:** 20’    **WIDTH:** 20’    **ZONE:** 6

**FOLIAGE:** Green with greyish-purple veins and tips turning yellow, orange and red in fall.

### Golden Glory Dogwood

## HOW TO PRUNE YOUR NELSON TREES FOR PLANTING

During the digging process on bareroot trees or transplanting from container grown liner (CGL), trees lose a portion of the root system they formerly had. To ensure rapid vigorous growth in their new location, the tops should be pruned back, and broken or bruised roots should be trimmed so there is a favorable balance of root over top. Leave as much of the root system as possible and always use clean sharp tools and make fresh clean cuts when pruning.

Damaged branches should be trimmed off below the point of injury. The central leader should be left intact to build a high crown and side branches should be shortened. If trees are to be planted into landscapes or containers, trim the branches back by at least a third (*see FOR LANDSCAPING illustration*). If planting for nursery stock rows, trim the branches back by at least half their length (*see FOR NURSERY illustration*). Scaffold branching may also be thinned for nursery trees to improve structure long term. One-third to one-half of the total branching may be removed, especially trees with dense canopies like weeping cherry. This harsh treatment results in rapid growth. Broken roots should be trimmed back above the break or bruised ends, leaving as much of the root system as possible, so they will regenerate fastest. This thinning of the crown and roots improves survival rate and regrowth while still preserving the apparent size of the tree.

## CARE & HANDLING

We take every precaution through the growing, harvesting, storage and shipping process so your stock arrives to you in the best possible condition. The trees are loaded into a temperature-controlled truck with the refrigeration set to 40 – 45°F, along with a Sensitech recorder to document the actual temperature inside the van.

### STORING

The trees must be protected from freezing conditions, ideally in a frost protected structure. Dehydration is a concern which can be mitigated by mulching the root stems with wet straw or other suitable mulch and keep damp, but not too wet. Material in containers should not be allowed to dry out.

Outside storage can work, where the roots are healed in sawdust or mulch. This is not recommended if temperatures are expected to be below freezing for an extended period due to damage to trunks and branches.

### PLANTING

Prior to planting, prune the root system following the pruning instructions on the previous page. If you remove 30% of the roots you need to reduce the length of the branches by 40-50%.

Soil should be moist, but not too wet, allowing the soil to blend around the root system. Irrigate in dry conditions as light rain fall may not offer adequate soil moisture.

Field fertilization is best done prior to planting. Soil tests can help to determine which amendments are needed. Once the trees are growing, additional fertilization may be necessary.
